- Farmer should be certified as per NPOP or PGS
- Farmer should have Animal husbandry component and composting unit
- Indian national farmers only can apply
- Scope Certificate to be attached

Terms & Conditions

- Applicants should provide their updated details with Aadhar card and passport photo.
- Application form should be verified by either Regional Council of PGS or official from the Certification Body. Application without attestation by either RC or CB will be rejected. Scope certificate/PGS Organic Certificate to be attached.
- By entering these awards, the applicant will be deemed to have read and understood the terms and conditions and be bound by them. These terms and conditions include any instructions set out in the application form.
- Applications which are not complete in every respect are liable to be rejected.
- Jury members of Jaivik India Awards reserves the right at its absolute discretion to reject any application that it deems inappropriate.
